The Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam is generally your first step in the process to becoming a professional licensed engineer (P.E.). It is designed for recent graduates and students who are close to finishing an undergraduate engineering degree from an EAC/ABET-accredited program. If you are considering entering a career where a P.E. license will be beneficial or required, taking the exam during, or just at the end of your senior year could be helpful.

FE Exam Preparation Options: There are several preparation options available, including exam prep textbooks, paid online study programs, and <u>NCEES</u> materials. Online prep program pricing varies.
